Principal Updates

- Waivers are due second Monday in April, two waivers are being written this does not mean the school will do it but provides Sherman the time to explore these options:
 - extended October Conference time to 3 days
 - To increase participation and time slots
 - INCREASE THE TIME for each conference, currently they are only 20 mins this would expand this
 - Support shared goal setting

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- This will have an impact, as it means extra days of early release
 - Suggestion of providing expanded Ycare support.
 - Would doing two full days vs. half days work?
 - This would impact instructional time
 - Are there opportunities for additional support from staff not doing conferences?
- 2 report cards vs 3
 - Algins with middle and high school schedules
 - Better alignment with STEAM teaching model
 - Trend of other district elementary schools are moving towards this.
- March 19th- is a national Walk-in to remind elected leaders that we want to protect our students and public schools. What is a walk in- collective action shows the power of the people.
 - Why March 19th elected officials return to their districts to hear from their constituents
 - Staff is asking if PTSA will support to get message out to caregiver community
 - At Sherman what makes sense- to wear red on March 19th, wear walk in at 9am
 - Liz will be taking photos and setting it up
