## Sherman Elementary PTSA 2026 Talent Show Rules

### TO BE ELIGIBLE:

- The show is open to grades TK 5th.
- Soloists and groups of up to 6 students are eligible.
- Students may perform in **ONLY ONE** act.
- All students must return a completed and signed Talent Show participation form by January 5th to the PTSA Mailbox, located in the front office.
- Students who are part of a group act (6 max) should submit each of their participation forms **together in one envelope.**

### PLANNING YOUR ACT/GUIDELINES:

- All acts will be limited to 2 minutes. Please plan accordingly.
- Lyrics, costumes, and performances should be compliant with school policy and appropriate for all audiences. Music and performances will be screened for appropriateness.
- Lip-synching, sing-a-long, or video games (guitar hero, just dance, etc) acts **will not be allowed**. Dance routines should be well rehearsed.
- Any student auditioning with gymnastics, martial arts, or other intensive training routines must be well trained.
- All equipment for the student's act must be provided by the student (sound system provided by the school).
- If your act requires music, the music must be:
  - Provided to the Talent Show committee at the time of auditions via Spotify or Apple Music.
  - Edited to be no longer than 2 minutes in length (if necessary).
- This is a show, not a contest. No Prizes will be awarded.
- Most of all...Be Creative, Show off your true talent and HAVE FUN!
